





What Duke Cunningham DID TO the Environment:


- Co-sponsored legislation to weaken provisions of the Clean Water Act protecting wetlands (HR 1330 in 1993)
- Voted <u>against</u> the California Desert Protection Act (7/14/94)
- Voted to cut \$1.2 billion from the EPA's Superfund Program and to eliminate the requirement for treating hazardous waste (11/22/93)
- Co-sponsored legislation to drastically <u>weaken</u> the Endangered Species Act (HR 1490 in 1993)

- Co-sponsored legislation to weaken laws protecting drinking water quality (HR 3392 in 1993)
- Sponsored legislation for a temporary ban on offshore drilling while publicly claiming it was permanent (Friends of Cunningham brochure, 1994)



What Duke Cunningham SAID About Crime in America:

security, Congress should pass a strong crime bill. Congress must recognize that each crime victimizes a family, a family which deserves justice and restitution. Americans rightly fear the randomness of crime and the increasingly violent nature of criminals. Tough action is needed and our results need to match our rhetoric.



What Duke Cunningham DID About Crime in America:

- Voted Against the Crime Bill (8/21/94)
- Voted Against the Assault Weapon Ban (5/5/94) and the Brady Handgun Control Bill (11/30/93)
- Voted to weaken the Brady Bill and undercut state and local gun control laws (11/10/93)
- Attacked the Crime Bill in a speech on the floor of the House because it includes "social spending" for crime and drug abuse prevention programs (8/10/94)





What Duke Cunningham SAID About Children

"I am in support of preventative medicine and believe that vaccinations should be provided to those who cannot afford them. Because, let's face it, none of us can allow our children to be sick." (Letter to the National Organization for Women, 1/8/94)

"...if we want and expect our children to perform better in school, we must make sure the children have the capacity to fully benefit from their education...If your kids are hungry, how much control do you have over them, or how much do they learn?" (Speech on House floor, 7/19/94)






What Duke Cunningham DID TO Children and Education:

- Was one of only 38 members of Congress to vote <u>against</u> a bill requiring warning labels on toys that pose a choking risk for small children (3/16/94)
- Voted against funding for childhood immunization five times! (10/29/91; 7/28/92; 3/19/93; 8/5/93; 10/7/93)
- Voted <u>against</u> Head Start funding five times! (4/17/91; 10/29/91; 11/6/91; 7/28/92; 3/19/93)
- Voted <u>against</u> funding the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) nutrition program (11/6/91; 11/19/91)

- Voted to cut funds to all school districts, eliminate new programs, and eliminate all funds for family planning in the Improving America's Schools Act of 1994 (3/24/94)
- Voted <u>against</u> the Goals 2000: Educate America Act of 1993, which encouraged states to set high scholastic standards (10/13/93)
- Twice voted to divert funds from public schools to pay tuition at private and parochial schools (8/12/92)





What Duke Cunningham SAID About Seniors:



What Duke Cunningham DID TO Seniors:

- Voted to cut Medicare on two occasions (11/22/93; 4/17/94)
- Introduced three bills to divert Medicare funds to other programs (HR 3349 on 9/17/91; HR 3957 on 11/26/91; HR 1778 on 4/21/93)
- Voted <u>against</u> a measure to protect low and middle income seniors from higher Social Security taxes (7/14/93)
- Voted <u>against</u> an amendment to the Balanced Budget Amendment that would have prevented further cuts in Social Security (6/11/94)
